



In 2021, the local governments in Nigeria received a combined **₦1.7 trillion (18.6%) of ₦9.1 trillion revenue** generated by the federal government of Nigeria. This amounts to billions of naira received monthly by these local governments. However, we are asking the local governments to account for how these monies were spent.
